3 Rights for Rehearing or judicial review will be lost without action taken in a timely
4 manner. A Party has the right to request a rehearing from the Department of Fire and
5 Life Safety pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09(A). In addition, the matter may be
6 reviewed by the Superior Court, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.08(H), although a party
7 may be required to seek a rehearing from the Department of Fire and Life Safety before
8 petitioning the Superior Court for such review. See A.R.S. § 41-1092.09(B). Further
9 rights may be lost without action taken in a timely manner. Parties may wish to review
10 these statutes as quickly as possible after receipt of this notice. The relevant statutes

13 Not later than ten days after a complaint for judicial review of an administrative decision
14 is filed with the Superior Court, the party who filed the complaint must file a notice of the
15 action with the Office of Administrative Hearings.
