Upon consideration of the parties' Assented Motion to Modify the Scheduling Order, the court orders as follows:

Paragraph 4 of the Scheduling Order is modified as follows:

Final Supplemental Disclosure: Each party shall provide final supplemental disclosure by ~~July 15, 2024~~ **October 30, 2024**.

All other parts of paragraph 4 remain unchanged.

Paragraph 5 of the Scheduling Order is modified as follows:

Discovery Deadlines: . . . The parties will propound all discovery undertaken pursuant to Rules 33 through 36 by ~~April 26, 2024~~ **Sept. 6, 2024**. The parties will complete the depositions of parties and lay witnesses by ~~June 28, 2024~~ **October 11, 2024**, and will complete the depositions of expert witnesses by ~~June 28, 2024~~ **October 11, 2024**. The parties will complete all other discovery by ~~August 15, 2024~~ **October 11, 2024**. . . . All other parts of paragraph 5 remain unchanged.

Firm dates: No stipulation of the parties that alters a filing deadline or a hearing date contained in the scheduling order will be effective without an order of this court approving the stipulation. Dates set forth in the scheduling order that govern court filings or hearings are firm dates, and may be modified only with this court's consent and for good cause. This court ordinarily will not consider a lack of preparation as good cause.

Further orders: The court further orders as follows:
