MINUTE ENTRY

The Court has reviewed Plaintiff's Motion for Finding of Facts and Law and Request for Emergency Temporary Restraining Order Without Notice filed June 10, 2020.

The Court is denying this Motion on two grounds. First, to the extent that the Motion can be deemed a Motion for Recosnideration under Rule 7.1(e), Plaintiff has failed to make a showing that the Court should reconsider its ruling on May 12, 2020. Second, Plaintiff is represented by counsel, who is the only party that can file motions on behalf of Plaintiff. The Court is aware that Plaintiff's counsel appeared under a notice of limited representation. However, the limited representation pertained to the injunctive relief requested by Plaintiff. This Motion pertains to the same issue. Further, Plaintiff's counsel has not notified the Court that his limited representation has ended. It also appears that Plaintiff's counsel has remained on the case for further proceedings. Additionally, Plaintiff admitted that she still has counsel, because the Motion was filed "without advise [sic] of my counsel."
