MINUTE ENTRY

The Court is in receipt of a one page document filed October 20, 2014, entitled Request for Emergency Order to Stay All Proceedings Until Notice of Constitutional Question is Intervened and Resolved by Arizona Attorney General Pursuant to Rule 5.1; in the Alternative Request for Emergency Stay of Sale Order Until a Hearing Can Be Held on Petitioner's Notice of Constitutional Question and Emergency Affidavit and petition to Stay Sale and Vacate the Judgment of Foreclosure (Request for Emergency Order). It appears that the Request was filed by Malik Bey. The Request is not accompanied by a certificate of service indicating whether it was served on Plaintiff.

As emergency relief is requested, the Court issues this ruling on an accelerated basis. The Request is denied, as there is no legal basis set forth in the Request for the relief that is sought. Judgment was entered on May 28, 2014, and the Court denied a Motion to Set Aside the Judgment and Decree of Foreclosure on July 29, 2014.
