MINUTE ENTRY

The Court considered Defendant's Motion to Dismiss or, in the Alternative, Motion for More Definite Statement (filed 03/05/2020), the Response, and the Reply. The Court agrees that it is difficult to follow Plaintiff's Complaint to understand his claims.

IT IS ORDERED granting the motion for more definite statement. Not later than **May 15, 2020**, Plaintiff must file and serve an amended complaint explaining what he alleges Defendant did or failed to do, when that action or inaction occurred, and the nature of Plaintiff's damages or injury. Plaintiff need not quantify any damages now but must explain how Defendant's action or inaction harmed him. Plaintiff must simultaneously mail a copy of his amended complaint to Defendant's lawyer when he files it with the Clerk. The Court may dismiss Plaintiff's claims if he does not file and serve an amended complaint as directed.
