MINUTE ENTRY

Plaintiff filed Plaintiff's Motion in Support of Appeal From Arbitration and Motion for Trial Setting (filed 01/25/2021). The Court already set a hearing to schedule a trial. [Min. Entry (filed 01/11/2021).] Plaintiff's submission totaled 106 pages, which apparently included contemplated trial exhibits. The Court is not considering Plaintiff's submission, and Defendant must not respond to it. When the Court sets a trial, the resulting minute entry will included detailed instructions about filing exhibits and so forth. Both sides must follow those instructions exactly. The Court and Court staff do not comb the file to try to find exhibits, witness lists, and such.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

The Court also wants to clarify that our rules do not allow any more briefing about the propriety or impropriety of the arbitration award. The Court is setting a trial date. That trial or summary judgment will be the forum to present evidence and arguments.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED prohibiting either side from filing any more submissions attacking or supporting the arbitration award.
