MINUTE ENTRY

Mr. Asuquo often has emailed this division's judicial assistant without copying Defendants' counsel. What is more, the subjects of the emails are not items warranting an email to Court staff, regardless of whether the sender copied all other parties on the email.

IT IS ORDERED prohibiting either side from emailing Court staff unless the Court requests such an email. The Court will sanction a party or lawyer who violates this order \$150.00 with that amount increasing for subsequent violations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED waiving Arizona Rule of Civil Procedure 26(d) in this case. All discovery disputes will be via a written motion to compel or motion for protective order. The Court reminds the parties of Maricopa County Local Rule 3.2(h) for motions to compel. The Court will summarily deny motions to compel that do not comply with that local rule.
