**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS**

Brown<sup>1</sup> participating, has reviewed Appellant's application for attorneys' fees and taxable costs and their statement of costs, both filed May 14, 2020; Appellee's untimely response filed June 2, 2020; and Appellant's untimely reply filed June 15, 2020. **IT IS ORDERED**, granting Appellant's statement of attorneys' fees and costs in part and awarding attorneys' fees in the amount of \$33,005.00 and costs in the amount of \$512.00 to Appellant and against Appellee.<sup>2</sup>
