IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's supplement shall also state what has been produced to the extent that that is necessary for the Court to understand the plaintiff's position on how the order remains not complied with.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within ten business days after the plaintiff's filing the defendant shall file a response. The plaintiff will then have five business days in which to file a reply. If the plaintiff believes (after receiving the response) that an evidentiary hearing is still necessary the plaintiff may make a request for an evidentiary hearing in his reply and the Court will take up the issue.

The Court will not address today the response date to the motions to dismiss. The parties have stipulated to November 13, 2017 and that will be the due date absent further agreement between the parties.
