24 The Court having considered the Joint Statement filed between Plaintiff, Norman  
25 Zwicky and Defendant, Premiere Vacation Collection Owners Association (the  
26 "Association"), by and through their counsel, with respect to the confidential treatment of  
27 certain documents produced by the Association to Norman Zwicky, **IT IS ORDERED** as  
28 follows:

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1. Defendant will compile all documents produced in the matter to date, will Bates label the documents, index the documents and note all documents that Defendant designates as "confidential," and produce the documents and an index to Plaintiff's counsel. **May 3, 2018** \_\_\_\_\_

2. Plaintiff will review the documents and provide a list to Defendant's counsel identifying any and all documents where Plaintiff disputes the "confidential" designation. **May 10, 2018** \_\_\_\_\_

3. Counsel for Plaintiff and Defendant shall "meet and confer" regarding the documents where the Parties disagree about the "confidential" designation. **May 17, 2018** \_\_\_\_\_

4. Defendant will file a Motion seeking to preserve the "confidential" designation over any documents that remain in dispute after the meet and confer. In the Motion, Defendant shall also identify any witnesses it intends to call at the evidentiary hearing. If Plaintiff seeks to depose such witnesses, then the Court shall extend the deadlines in this Scheduling Order to accommodate Plaintiff taking such depositions. **May 31, 2017** \_\_\_\_\_


5. Plaintiff will file a Response to the Motion disputing the "confidential" designation over any documents that remain in dispute after the meet and confer. **June 11, 2018** \_\_\_\_\_

6. Defendant shall file its Reply Brief. **June 15, 2018** \_\_\_\_\_

All filings will be delivered to the opposing party by hand-delivery or, if the parties agree, electronically. The court copies of the response and reply shall be e-mailed directly to Division staff.

If necessary, the Court will hold a two (2) hour evidentiary hearing on **June 19, 2018 @ 9:00 a.m.**, to determine whether the documents that remain in dispute should remain confidential.
